

## **Submission of Posters and Communications from 15/04/2026 to 30/09/2026**

The Organising Committee invites the submission of posters and scientific communications related to the field of patient experience. Submissions must be made exclusively through the online platform within the established deadlines.

Guidelines for the Submission of Communications

### **1. Language**

All abstracts must be written in Spanish or English.

### **2. Authors and workplaces**

Submissions must be made through the online platform provided for this purpose.

A maximum of six (6) authors will be allowed, including the main author, who will be responsible for presenting the work at the Congress.

The following information must be provided for each author:

Full name and surname

Workplace

In addition, the following must be included:

Contact email address of the main author

### **3. Title**

The abstract title must meet the following requirements:

Be written in capital letters

Have a maximum length of 150 characters

Be clear and concise, accurately reflecting the nature of the study or experience presented

Avoid the use of abbreviations wherever possible

### **4. Abstract text**

The abstract text must not exceed 600 words, excluding the bibliography.

If abbreviations are used, the full term must appear before its first use, followed by the abbreviation in brackets.

### **5. Abstract structure**

The abstract must be clearly structured and must include the following headings:

Introduction

Objective

Methodology

Results

Conclusions

Bibliography, if applicable, in Vancouver style, with a maximum of 7 references



## **6. Criteria for coherence and scientific quality**

For proper evaluation, the abstract must meet the following criteria:

The different sections must be properly ordered and coherent with each other

The methodology used must be appropriate to the stated objective

The results must derive from the method described

The conclusions must be based on the results obtained

The abstract must provide sufficient, clear and rigorous information on the content of the proposed communication or poster, so that the relevance, quality and contribution of the work presented in the field of patient experience can be properly assessed.
